



APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION INTO SIXTH FORM

Applicants should note:

Candidates for sixth form admission are required to have a **MINIMUM** of **five (5)** CXC General subjects or equivalent, *including English Language (English A)*, taken at one sitting. Subjects taken in fourth form may be considered as the same sitting as those taken in fifth form.

SIXTH FORM OPTIONS

Candidates are required to list in order of priority, their preferred **schools** (*maximum of four (4) different schools*) and **combinations of three (3) subjects** for sixth form study. **For some schools, candidates have the option of selecting up to three (3) combinations of three (3) subject choices.**

The eleven (11) schools available are Combermere School (**CS**), Harrison College (**HC**), The Lodge School (**LS**), Queen's College (**QC**), The St. Michael School (**SM**), Christ Church Foundation (**CF**), St Leonard's Boys' Secondary School (**LB**), Springer Memorial Secondary School (**SP**) Alexandra School (**AX**), Alleyne School (**AL**) and Ellerslie Secondary School (**EL**).

Please note that the eleven (11) sixth form schools offer different subject combinations, and that certain subjects require specific qualifications. Therefore, you MUST refer to the information provided on *Sixth Form School Subject Options* BEFORE making your selections.

PLEASE NOTE:

- (i) Students currently taking Additional Mathematics and wish to be considered for the Sixth Form Mathematics Programme indicate on the form in the tick box provided.
- (ii) **The deadline for submission of applications is September 28th, 2020.**
- (iii) Promotion to Upper 6th is dependent on students successfully completing the compulsory subjects and at least 2 core subjects.
- (iv) Acceptance to Sixth Form is conditional on students adhering to the schools' policy, rules and regulations.

The following information should be carefully read as you prepare yourself for sixth form study:

- (i) Students must have a minimum of five (5) subjects or equivalent including English A at Caribbean Examinations Council (CXC) General Proficiency Level; and

(ii) A Grade 1 or 2 is preferred in the subjects requested for sixth form study.

SIXTH FORM SUBJECT OPTIONS 2020-2021

The following information should be carefully read as you prepare yourself for sixth form study.

- (1) All students entering sixth form will be pursuing the Caribbean Advanced Proficiency Examination (CAPE). GCSE Advanced Level examinations will only be taken in subjects not offered by CAPE.
- (2) The recommended minimum grade for the study of a particular subject in sixth form is a CXC General Grade 1 or a GCSE Ordinary Level Grade A or B. CXC General Grade II passes may be accepted subject to the profiles.
- (3) Qualification in CXC English B or GCSE Ordinary Level English Literature is required for the study of English in sixth form.
- (4) Qualification in Mathematics (CXC Grade I or II or GCSE Ordinary Level Grade A, B or C) is a prerequisite for the study of Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Geography and Management of Business in sixth form.
- (5) Qualification in Principles of Accounts (CXC Grade I or II or GCSE Ordinary Level Grade A, B or C) is required for the study of Management of Business in sixth form.
- (6) Qualification in Chemistry (CXC Grade I or II or GCSE Ordinary Level Grade A, B or C) is a prerequisite for the study of Biology in sixth form.
- (7) For the CAPE GMED (Geometrical and Mechanical Engineering Drawing) a Grade I or II in Technical Drawing – Mechanical Engineering option and a Grade I or II in Mathematics are prerequisites.
- (8) For Environmental Science, a Grade I or II in Geography or Biology is a prerequisite.
- (9) For Economics, a Grade 1 in Mathematics is a prerequisite.
- (10) For Law, a Grade 1 in English Literature or History is a prerequisite.
- (11) For Green Engineering, qualification in Chemistry, Physics, Mathematics, Industrial Technology are prerequisites.

(12) For Animation and Game Design a Grade 1 or 2 in Art, Information Technology, English Literature/Theatre Arts is a prerequisite.
